<p>2023 EUROPA Competition</p>	<p>Joint Motif</p>	 <p>2023 EUROPA Stamps theme “PEACE – the highest value of humanity” will be based on a common design motif to be issued by all postal companies in 2023. Out of the 29 entries submitted for the design competition, 44 postal companies participating in the voting have selected the design motif of POST Luxembourg, depicting “The New Peace Symbol”.</p> <p>Story of the design: The world needs a new Peace symbol, uniting all nations. Cultural differences perchance a barrier for a state of Peace. If only mankind could respect each other's differences by understanding their significance and responding to them with consideration, the world would be a better place. This design shows a visual metaphor for a peacefully integrated, cooperative society in which people embrace each other’s culture. It was inspired by the Celtic Love Knot symbol, with interlocking hearts. The colour palette illustrates all the nations in the world. By adding hands with intertwined fingers, it conveys the message of mutual respect.</p>	 <p>POST Luxembourg Luxembourg</p>

In 963, he built his castle on the Bock promontory, above the Alzette, for his lovely wife, who had laid down two conditions before consenting to the marriage: she wished to be alone every Saturday at noon without being disturbed. Siegfried’s curiosity allegedly led him to observe his wife on a Saturday through the keyhole and discover that her legs were turning into a fishtail. <p>2021 EUROPA Competition</p>	<p>National Endangered Wildlife</p>	 <p>The Polish word “RYŚ” (lat. Lynx lynx) is a proto-Slavic expression meaning "FAST", featuring the unique endangered wild animal. Now, merely 123 individuals of the Eurasian lynx live in Poland, mainly in isolated large forest complexes of the Carpathians and wilderness forests of eastern Poland, like the Białowieża Forest and the Augustów Forest. The reintroduction of lynxes begun as part of the project "Return of the lynx to north-west Poland" in 2019. The design of the Polish stamp EUROPA 2021 symbolically refers to numerous threats of the modern world for the survival of the animal.</p>	 <p>Poczta Polska Poland</p>

<p>2019 Jury Competition</p>	<p>National Birds</p>	 <p>This small, orange-brown social bird with a very long stepped tail measures 16–17 cm from the tip of its beak to the end of its tail. It lives in thick stands of reeds, where it is most frequently observed in low flight, beating its short wings rapidly. It likes to perch in the tops of reeds, particularly in the early morning and in autumn. Its diet consists of insects and seeds. It builds a bowl-shaped nest near the ground in reeds that bend over water. It lays five to seven white spotted eggs and has two to three broods a year. <p>2018 Online Competition</p>	<p>Bridges</p>	 <p>The Edirne Uzunköprü Bridge was built between 1426 and 1443, during the reign of Sultan Murat II.. It is located on the Ergene River in Uzunköprü, a county belonging to the Edirne Province. With a length of 1392 meters, a width of 5,40 meters and with 174 arches, it is considered to be the World's longest and still standing stone bridge. It has been included in the UNESCO World Heritage Tentative List, together with a joint study from the Ministries of Culture and Tourism, in cooperation with the General Directorate of Highways.</p>	 <p>Turkish PTT Turkey</p>
<p>2018 Jury Competition</p>	<p>Bridges</p>	 <p>For this stamp issue, we have chosen one of the oldest bridges that still exists in Belgium. The 'Pont des Trouis' is located in the city of Tournai/Doornik. This bridge is still one of the oldest in Europe, dating back to the 13th century. 


